Who we are

Kindernothilfe Luxembourg was founded in June 2009 with the objective to help children in disadvantaged areas of the world.

In the following two years the organisation developed based on voluntary work. In 2011, the organisation moved to its first office in Luxembourg-Neudorf. Since 2015, it has its headquarter in Luxembourg-Eecherschmelz.

Furthermore in May 2013 Kindernothilfe Luxembourg received the recognition as a non-governmental organisation (ONG) from the Foreign Ministry of Luxembourg.

Donations to Kindernothilfe Luxembourg are tax deductible. Our annual financial statements are reviewed by an independent certified auditor and published in the Commercial Register.

What we do

We protect, support and strengthen children that are living in the poorest regions of the world. The people involved in providing help must be aware of local traditions. Therefore we work exclusively with experienced local partners.

Emergency aid: We supply necessities and protect children during and after humanitarian disasters.

Sustainable projects: We work together with the people in need to search for efficient solutions that are effective and sustainable in the long term. Education is one of the most important factors we consider as it promotes autonomy.

Educational work: We inform the public about our projects and the situation of children in the poorest countries of the world.

Where we help

Education and independence are particularly important to us. Currently we are mainly active in the following countries:

Vocational training for children at risk in Malawi: Children that are in risk of poverty can undergo a three month respectively two year vocational skills training program with the aim to gain employment afterwards so that they can lead independent lives.

Aid to Syrian refugee children in Lebanon: At our refuge, children receive regular meals and psycho-social support. The courses prepare them for admission to Lebanese State schools.

Demo farm project helps to feed people in the countryside: young people and small farmers learn how they can farm their land effectively with the aid of mixed cultivation and typhoon-resistant species. In this way they can protect themselves against disasters and secure food for their families.

A strong network: As an independent Luxembourgish organisation we are working on an international basis with Kindernothilfe in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. This provides us access to a common network of experienced partner organisations.

Main topics: Education, Nutrition, Protection of children, poverty reduction

Approach: Local partners, supporting independence (self help-approach), building up children's rights
